# Personal-size tissue holder.

To complete this project you will need two 9"x7" pieces of contrasting fabric. You can make 6 holders from 2 fat quarters.

Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout the project.

Cutting Instructions are for 3 different size holders.

### Small:

Main fabric (outside of cover) 6.5" x 5.5" Contrast fabric (inside and band) 8" x 5.5"

#### Medium:

Main fabric (outside of cover) 6.75" x 5.75" Contrast fabric (inside and band) 8.25" x 5.75"

### Large:

Main fabric (outside of cover) 7" x 6" Contrast fabric (inside and band) 8.5" x 6"

Medium fits most personal-size tissue packets. Some special holiday editions may be smaller than the standard-size packets so you may want to make the "small" size. If you prefer a roomier case then you should make the large size holder.

## Assembly:

- With RST sew the two pieces of fabric together down both short ends
- Turn RSO.
- Press with about a 3/8" band on each side.
- Fold in half and press on the fold to create a crease down the middle of the holder.

• With the Main fabric facing up, fold the sides into the center, using the center fold as a guide, overlapping by

about 1/8 "

- Pin in place, then sew across both ends, backstitching over the sections where the two sides overlap.
- Turn RSO, push out the corners, and press.

RST - right sides together. RSO - right side out
